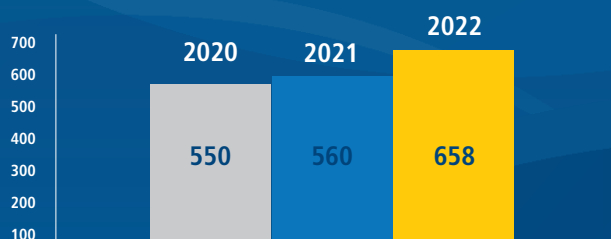

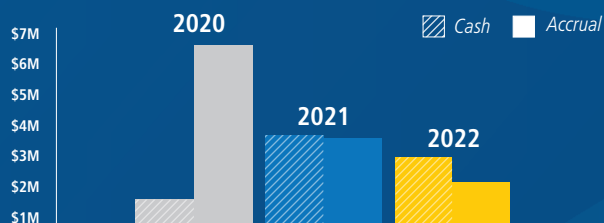

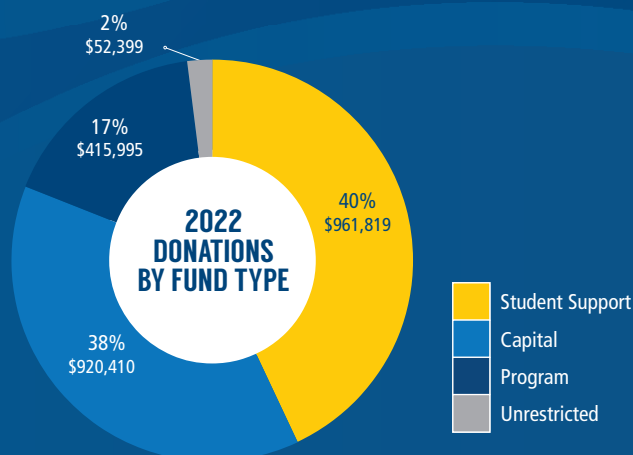
TOTAL DONORS

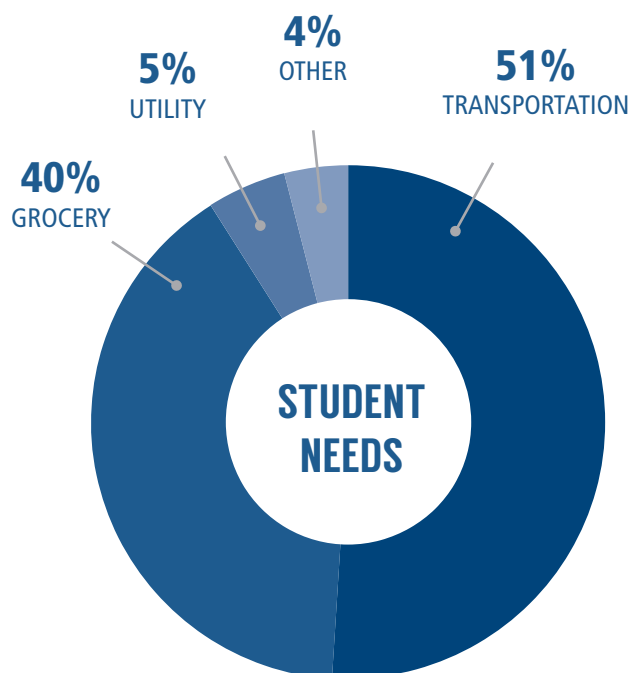
